


FLORIDA KEYS COMMERCIAL FISHING INDUSTRY


>4,500 jobs - 2nd largest

\$900 million economic impact










Trap Locations from Flyover on 9/23-25







FLORIDA SEA GRANT SAVES SPINY LOBSTER INDUSTRY \$4 MILLION

- 60,000 traps recovered
- 65% reusable: \$1.56 million
- 150 boat days

 Fuel \$31,500
 Crew \$82,500
 Lobster \$2.28 million

Total: \$3.95 million
